ROLE OVERVIEW

The President of the Students' Union is the lead student representative for UUSU and its members and acts as the main liaison between the University and Students. They are responsible for leading the organisation, through Chairing Trustee Board, as well as managing the Student Executive Team. The President is a figurehead of the organisation and will have significant external profile duties to fulfil. The remit of the post is broad and covers everything from our day to day operations to setting and delivering the strategic aspirations of our membership.

Leadership

- Lead the UUSU Officer Team, ensuring Officers are supported to set and achieve their yearly goals;
- Chairperson of the UUSU Trustee Board, and responsibility to ensure good governance and financial stewardship of UUSU;
- Student representative on Ulster University Council; ensuring the voice of students is amplified at the highest decision making body in the university.
- Delegate lead for all student conferences.

Representation

- Represent the collective interests of all UUSU students to the University, local and national government and other relevant stakeholders;
- To be the spokesperson for UUSU to all internal and external audiences and across print, broadcast and digital media.
- Regularly liaises and meets with the Vice Chancellor and other senior university staff on behalf of the union and our membership.

Campaigning

- Ensure UUSU is an effective campaigning organisation;
- Lead on planning UUSU campaigns and oversee delivery of such.
- Lead on implimentation of student passed policy and oversee delivery.
