The President of UUSU is the lead representative for UUSU and students. They are responsible for leading the organisation, through Chairing Trustee Board, as well as managing the Student Executive Team. The President is a figurehead of the organisation and will have significant external profile duties to fulfil.

Leadership

- Lead the UUSU Officer Team, ensuring Officers are supported to set and achieve their yearly goals;
- Chairperson of the UUSU Trustee Board, and responsibility to ensure good governance and financial stewardship of UUSU;
- Student representative on Ulster University Council;
- Delegate lead for all student conferences.

Representation

- Represent the collective interests of all UUSU students to the University, local and national government and other relevant stakeholders;
- To be the spokesperson for UUSU to all internal and external audiences and across print, broadcast and digital media.

Campaigning

- Ensure UUSU is a campaigning organisation;
- Lead on planning UUSU campaigns and oversee delivery of such.
